Select GRAPH mode from the main menu by using the arrow keys to highlight the GRAPH icon or pressing 5.



N.B. The more graphs that you experience drawing on the graphical calculator the more familiar you will get with understanding the relationship between the graphs and their equations that are represented algebraically.

To set up the V-Window (Graph Viewing Window) for the graph that you want to see.

To get the V-Window press **SHIFT** **F3**

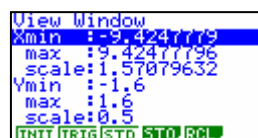
Then **EXIT** to move back to the previous window.

Degree

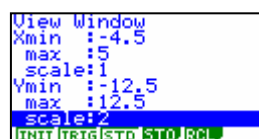
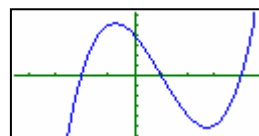
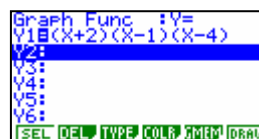
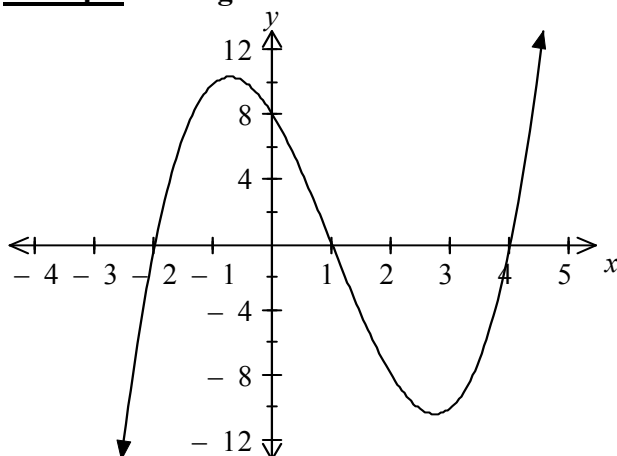


or **Radian measure**
