Example 1: Draw the vertical line $x = 1$

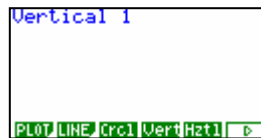

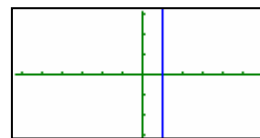

Example 2: Draw the vertical line $y = 2$

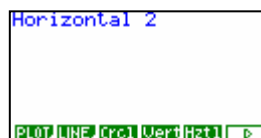

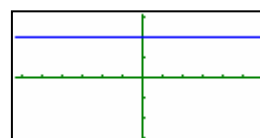

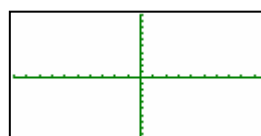
A Initial setting

F3



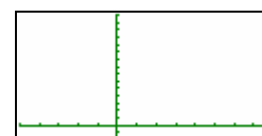
